

## **Northern Illinois Disposal Trash and Yard Waste Restrictions**

All trash needs to be in store bought cans no greater than 32 gallons and weighing less than 50 lbs. Please have all trash in cans or in bags. Loose items cause litter in your neighborhood and is also time consuming for the driver to pick up off the ground.

### **TRASH LIMITS:**

\*Unlimited household trash. The definition of household trash is the amount of trash that is acquired during a normal week in your household. Anything more will be subject to extra charge to resident.

- 1) No construction or remodel debris
- 2) Carpet needs to be no bigger than 4 foot rolls bundled with tape or twine. They need to be manageable for the driver to pick up and put into the truck.
- 3) Bulk items can be left at the curb on your pick up day. One or two items are sufficient.
- 4) Paint cans (water based) need to be completely dry or emptied with lids off. (Oil and Latex) need to be completely empty with lids off.

### **YARD WASTE ( Leaves, Sticks, and Grass)**

All yard waste needs to be in Biodegradable Lawn bags or in trash cans no bigger than 32 gallons with a large "X" placed on the side of the can facing the street. The cans need to be less than 50 lbs. Yard Waste is Unlimited.

**In case of a move out, an eviction, or any remodel of any kind (including flood damage) the owner needs to call Northern Illinois Disposal @ 800.930.7321 to set up for a roll off container. We will not pick up these items at the curb.**

## Northern Illinois Disposal Recycling Restrictions

Place the following items directly into your bin. Please do not place in separate bags. Recycle is unlimited but needs to be within the following guidelines.

### • • • NO SEPARATING REQUIRED • • •

**GLASS:** Rinse out all glass containers, labels do not need to be removed. We accept clear, green and brown (amber glass).

**ALUMINUM AND TIN:** Rinse out all food and beverage containers. We now accept formed aluminum containers (example: Disposable pie plates). We also accept clean aluminum foil/tin cans and aluminum cans.

**PAPER:** Place in the bins—newspaper (including advertising supplements), magazines, brown grocery bags, telephone books, catalog, office paper, junk mail, envelopes (any type). We accept empty chipboard (example: cereal boxes), wet strength carrier stock (example: 12 pack beverage boxes), frozen food packages (example: TV dinner boxes), and juice boxes.

**CARDBOARD:** Place under bin—clean corrugated cardboard boxes or shipping boxes. Break down or cut boxes so they are flat and no longer than 2x2 ft. Cardboard needs to be bundled.

**PLASTIC:** At this time we collect 1 through 7 plastic containers. To recognize these please look at the bottom of the container for the recycling symbol 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7. Rinse and place in bin. (Examples: pop bottles, milk bottles, detergent bottles, bleach bottles, butter tubs, sour cream cartons, dip containers.)

**PLEASE NOTE—WE DO NOT TAKE:** *Styrofoam, rubber bands, plastic bags, soiled paper (example: pizza boxes), tissue paper, paper towels or wax-coated paper., crystal, perfume bottles, windows, light colored red and blue glass bottles and no broken glass.*
