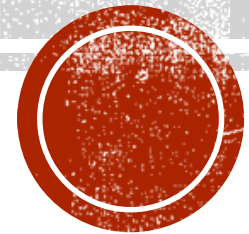

NON-HIGHWAY VEHICLES DEFINED

- Golf Carts
- Utility Vehicles
- Operates between 15-25mph
- Has four wheels
- Does not include four-wheeler



PERMIT

- Permitted at Rochelle Police Department
- Requires proof of valid Illinois Drivers License
- Requires proof of liability insurance
- Must display registration sticker on vehicle
- Permit cost:
 - First-time applicant - \$75
 - Annual Renewal - \$50
 - Senior Citizen (65+) Application or Renewal - \$35
 - Registration cost is not pro-rated



AREAS & HOURS OF OPERATION

- Roadways within City limits
- Exclusions: Route 251, Route 38, I-88, I-39, Caron Road, Veteran's Parkway, 20th Street, Flagg Road, Steward Road, Dement Road
- Crossing an excluded street is permitted at a 90 degree angle, providing no obstruction exists
- Not permitted on bike path or Park District property
- Not permitted on sidewalks
- Hours of operation
 - Sunday – Thursday 6AM to 11PM
 - Friday – Saturday 6AM to Midnight



SAFETY

- Maximum occupancy: limited to number of seats in vehicle
- All non-highway vehicles must have the following safety equipment:
 - Brakes
 - Steering apparatus
 - Four tires
 - Rear view mirror
 - Red reflectors on front & rear
 - Slow-moving emblem on the rear
 - Tail lamp
 - Brake lights
 - Turn signals
 - Headlight



PENALTIES

- First offense: \$100
- Second offense: \$250
- Third offense: \$500 and revocation of permit for one year
- All owners/drivers subject to Illinois Vehicle Code
 - No open containers of alcohol or driving under the influence
